

As part of our commitment to sustainable communities, Landscape Structures has partnered with Global ReLeaf, a program of American Forests, to plant trees around the globe to offset the carbon produced in the manufacturing of our playstructures. These include PlayBooster®, PlayShaper®, PlaySense® and Evos™. A donation will be made with every playground sale in 2008 to purchase enough trees to offset the carbon dioxide produced while manufacturing that specific playground. An educational playground sign will be available for purchase that explains the environmental benefits of the partnership between LSI and Global ReLeaf.



WE'RE PART OF THE SOLUTION

As part of our sustainability programs, we have calculated the carbon footprint of a Landscape Structures playstructure, based on the energy used during the manufacturing of the structure. Evos has a 30% smaller carbon footprint than our traditional playstructures—PlayBooster®, PlayShaper® and PlaySense®, and requires fewer carbon offsets.

The chart below represents the approximate number of trees that will be planted as a result of our donations.
