The Hills District All-Abilities Park, adjacent to Leslie Patrick Park, was the culmination of an extensive design collaboration between Playscape Creations and Moreton Bay Regional Council to achieve this unique All Abilities Playspace. With a heart full of passion and a distinct vision in mind it was Councillor Matt Constance's mission to create a truly inclusive all abilities and all ages park for Moreton Bay and Brisbane families and after years of planning the result has been tremendously well received by the community.

Through a holistic space vision that considers the synergy of each element, interconnecting pathways invite users to explore the entirety of the space while ensuring that every piece of equipment is wheelchair accessible. Majestic Fig trees border one side of the park, offering abundant shade within the lush natural environment.

An accessible play structure forms the centrepiece of this bee themed playground, and the ancillary items help to create a space with something for everyone. Play zoning was incorporated to allow for age and ability suitability with a junior and senior play system, a sensory sand and water play zone, a 5-way swing with a variety of swing seats for varying ages and abilities, embankment play, misting totems, musical instruments, rocking, spinning, digging and numerous sliding opportunities to name a few.

Sensory Gardens interspersed within and surrounding the playspace promote an intergenerational interface as well as providing additional sensory stimulation for children. And with All Abilities amenities and BBQ's, visitors are invited to stay and play longer.
